Amman 350 JOINS THOUSANDS OF CANDLELIGHT VIGILS TO DEMAND A REAL DEAL AT THE COPENHAGEN CLIMATE TALKS

There's a global mobilization—organized by many different groups in the TckTckTck coalition and the Global Climate Campaign—planned for the weekend of December 11-12 right in the middle of the Copenhagen climate conference. At **350.org**, the focus for the weekend is on coordinating candlelight vigils at iconic and strategic locations around the world on Friday and Saturday nights. As climate negotiators gather in Copenhagen, **Amman residents** will hold a candlelight vigil in the **Roman Amphitheater/downtown** on **Friday 11 December** night to demonstrate public support for an agreement strong enough to actually slow climate change. This local action will join thousands of coordinated vigils happening in more than 100 countries as part of "The World Wants a Real Deal" campaign to demand a fair, ambitious and binding climate agreement.

WHAT: On the weekend in the middle of the Copenhagen conference, Dec. 11-13, people will be gathering at important places all over the world for candlelight vigils, in solemn solidarity with the citizens of those nations who will be first to face the challenge to their very survival posed by climate change. ABOUT "The World Wants a Real Deal" AND 350.org

"The World Wants a Real Deal" is a joint effort coordinated by the TckTckTck, 350.org, and Avaaz campaigns to call for a fair, ambitious and binding climate treaty in Copenhagen.

350.org coordinated an International Day of Climate Action in late October that CNN called "the most widespread day of political action in the planet's history," with 5,200 rallies in 181 countries. The campaign is calling on world leaders to create a climate agreement that lowers the level of carbon dioxide in the atmosphere below 350 parts per million, what scientists say is the safe upper limit.
